

LITTLE GHOST

Mini crochet amigurumi • Beginner pattern • approx. 2 × 2.75 in



MATERIALS

- White yarn
- 3.5 mm (E) crochet hook
- 2 black 6 mm safety eyes
- Black embroidery floss + needle
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Yarn needle, scissors, stitch marker



BEFORE YOU BEGIN

The ghost is worked in continuous rounds. Place a stitch marker in the first stitch of every round. On Body Rnd 13, work in the front loop only (FLO). The unused back loops will be used to sew on the base.

sc = single crochet	hdc = half double crochet	inc = 2 sc in same stitch
FLO = front loop only	MR = magic ring	st(s) = stitch(es)

Don't worry about memorizing everything - we'll learn each stitch together!

BODY • white yarn

- Rnd 1 6 sc in a magic ring. (6)
- Rnd 2 Inc in each stitch. (12)
- Rnd 3 [1 sc, 1 inc] × 6. (18)
- Rnd 4 [2 sc, 1 inc] × 6. (24)
- Rnd 5-12 1 sc in each stitch. (24)
- Rnd 13 FLO: [3 hdc in next stitch, 1 sc in each of next 2 stitches] × 8. (40) Fasten off and weave in the end.

Face: place the safety eyes between Rnds 7 and 8, about 3 stitches apart. Ask an adult for help securing the backs. Embroider the little mouth with black floss.

BASE • white yarn

- Rnd 1 6 sc in a magic ring. (6)
- Rnd 2 Inc in each stitch. (12)
- Rnd 3 [1 sc, 1 inc] × 6. (18)
- Rnd 4 [2 sc, 1 inc] × 6. (24) Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

ARMS • make 2

- Rnd 1 5 sc in a magic ring. (5)
- Rnd 2-3 1 sc in each stitch. (5) Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing. Do not stuff.

ASSEMBLY

Sew the arms to the sides of the body around Rnds 9-11. Then use the long tail from the base to sew its 24 stitches to the unused back loops from Body Rnd 13. Before closing completely, add fiberfill. Finish sewing, secure the yarn, and hide the end inside.



BOO! YOU DID IT!

Your little ghost is finished. Give the arms a tiny shape with your fingers and check that the base is securely sewn on.

Tip: because the body is all one color, this is a great project for practicing even stitches.
